Teams of well-known personalities surfed against each other in a tag-team style event, with the winners scoring \$5000 to donate to their chosen charities including Aim for the Stars, Cherish the Children, Melanoma Foundation, Planet Ark, National Breast Cancer and Unicef.

Michael Slater and Debbie Watson.
